Community Crisis Response Team

CCRT is a community-based mobile crisis team that provides assistance to those who are experiencing a mental health related emergency. Available 24 hours a day/7 days a week.

Children can be referred to CCRT who:

- May have recently expressed a wish to kill himself/herself
- May have threatened or assaulted someone else
- May have mild to moderate lacerations due to self-injury
- May have recently destroyed significant property
- May be exhibiting at-risk behaviors
- Do not require handcuffs
- Do not require urgent medical care
